A MESSAGE FROM THE BUSINESS MANAGER

As we move into the summer months, our work picture continues to be very promising. According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, Construction in Arizona has increased 6.5% between March 2017 and March 2018 with Mining increasing 6.3% in the same time period. 2018 has been a very productive year in relationship to jobs and market growth for our Local Union. The U.S. unemployment rate fell just below 4% to 3.9%. Arizona's unadjusted rate for April 2018 is at 4.4% with Pima County a little lower at 4.1% and Yuma at 15.7%. The construction specialty trades have increased in Tucson 6% between April 2017 and April 2018, with Yuma increasing 4.2%. What does all this mean for our future? The outlook is very encouraging if we continue to organize the non-represented workers and engage the non-signatory contractors while at the same time supporting our signatory contractors thru productivity, allowing them the opportunity to capture projects to sustain our good fortune of full employment.

The hard work by every member of Local 570 over the past year has paid off with greater market share. It is up to us to continue building our Local's market share throughout southern Arizona. I welcome any suggestions or insight you may have to advance this goal. Great job by everyone.


