# A MESSAGE FROM THE BUSINESS MANAGER

In 2017 and 2018, Local 570 has been very successful on many facets. We've had full employment for our membership, made improvements to our property, and



increased our market share according to the NECA 2017 annual report. We are expecting a further market share increase in 2018 once that report is released. We have organized many non-represented workers into our ranks through our Construction Electrician program. Our Apprenticeship Program increased the number of apprentices selected in 2017 and 2018 to allow more graduating apprentices for the future years. Our organizing staff continues to meet with non-signatory contractors and non-represented workers to assist in establishing higher wages for all workers.

It would be very easy to write more about our past achievements, but we must continue to work for the future. It is imperative that we do not rest on our successes but continue to build and grow our market share, educate our workforce, and organize all workers so they too can benefit from working under a Collective Bargaining Agreement. We must persist in building relationships with non-signatory contractors to further our organizing opportunities. We can strengthen our relationships with Signatory Contractors by providing a skilled workforce and following the guidelines of the IBEW Code of Excellence.

Our fight for higher wages, better working conditions and a higher standard of living does not end when we have a couple of good years. Our efforts must continue into the future to prevent us from returning to high unemployment, little or no wage increase, and loss of market share. Every Brother and Sister that gives 8 hours of work for 8 hours of pay, who shows up to work on time every day, ready to go to work, who promotes and protects all those around them, these are the Brothers and Sisters who are doing the most for this Local every day.
